Ousmane Sonko vows to raise peanut prices to empower Senegalese farmers

With early legislative elections scheduled for November 17, Ousmane Sonko, leader of the Pastef party and national list head of his coalition, has reaffirmed his commitment to support Senegalese farmers through a planned increase in the price of peanuts.
